Career interviews:

These are now underway. Everyone will have at least two during Year 11, but you may request extra if you need some further advice and guidance. If this is the case, please ask your Tutor, or Reception, to let me know.

Important reminders regarding preparation for career interviews:

- Venue: B7 (Upstairs in the English, between Mr Jardine's Office and Mrs Morrison's classroom)
- Be punctual. Attend a few minutes before your interview. This should be the case with any appointment / interview you are attend, as it creates a positive impression from the start. First impressions do count.
- Complete your pre-interview questionnaire in as much constructive detail as you can and bring it with you. This will help to make the most of the appointment time that you have.
- You will be provided with a copy of the notes I make of the interview, along with any support, prospectuses, etc. It is important to share this with your parents / carers. A copy will also be put in your file.

Make every effort to attend at least two Open events. This will give you a better idea of what studying is like at different local colleges.
