



A culture of **Care**: The parable of the Good Samaritan

- The parable of the Good Samaritan was used by Jesus as a response to a question about eternal life. He explained that care was key to everything we do. We should show care even to those we consider 'strangers' or 'enemies', and, in reality, no matter how righteous someone appears, they will be judged and valued based on how caring they are. At various times in life, we take on the role of both Samaritan and the injured person. It is OK to be both.
- "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind" and, "Love your neighbour as yourself" **Luke 10: 27**
