Year 11 Summer Ball 2026 – Friday 26th June 2026 – Invite

I am pleased to be writing with regards to the Year 11 Summer Ball 2026, which your child is invited to attend.

The event will be taking place at Ludlow Racecourse and we ask that students start arriving at 6.30pm. The dress code for the evening will be formal attire/Black Tie. Parents and spectators are kindly requested to park on the tarmac carpark opposite the Racecourse entrance or the gravel area adjacent to the arriver's circle. For health and safety, please avoid the area outside of the venue entrance and pay attention to the directions of staff who will be acting as stewards on the evening.

Photographs will be taken throughout the night, including during arrival. There will be an opportunity for all students to have a formal photograph and our photographer has created a special website where these will be able to be downloaded. During the evening, students have elected to have a buffet meal. Water will be provided on tables and soft drinks are also available free of charge. All students will be entered into a raffle with their entry ticket and prizes will be drawn on the evening. Students who have 100% attendance and have been invited to the summer ball will have an extra ticket in the evening's raffle.

The summer ball will finish at 11:00pm and we ask that parents make arrangements for students to be collected promptly from the venue.

This year, we are pleased to say that due to student's fundraising throughout the year, we are able to offer tickets at a cost of £30 per person. All payments must be made by SCOPAY by Friday June 12th .

Behaviour and conduct of students is to remain excellent throughout the night. Students are to remember that they still represent Ludlow School and should behave accordingly. Students who fail to behave in a suitable manner will be directed to leave the summer ball and parents will be contacted to collect them. No alcohol or smoking implements (including vapes) are permitted on site. Anyone found to be in possession of, or under the influence of, these items will also be directed to leave.

Please note that should your child fall short of the School's expectations before the Summer Ball, the privilege of attending may still be revoked. A refund would not be given at that point.

We look forward to what promises to be another amazing opportunity to celebrate our young people. It is a rite of passage and promises to be a fantastic evening.
