Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you to everyone who attended the Year 10 Parents' Evening on 5 February 2026. It was wonderful to see so many of you there, and we appreciate the time you took to complete the OFSTED questionnaire.

I hope you found the evening helpful and that you now feel well-informed about how to support your child with their progress for the remainder of this academic year and into Year 11.

Below are the key results from the questionnaire you completed. Your feedback is extremely valuable to us and helps us continue to improve the experience and outcomes for students at Ludlow CE School.

It is reassuring to see that:

- 100% of parents/carers agree or strongly agree that their child is happy at Ludlow CE School.
- 100% agree or strongly agree that their child feels safe at school.
- 88% agree or strongly agree that the school ensures pupils are well behaved.
- 90% report that their child has not been bullied; 100% of those who reported bullying felt it was dealt with quickly and effectively.
- 100% agree that the school gives their child the support they need to succeed.
- 90% feel the school communicates well with parents and carers.
- 90% feel that concerns raised are dealt with properly.
- 100% believe the school acts in students' best interests.
- 90% feel the school supports their child well.
- 83% would recommend Ludlow CE School to another parent.

Thank you for such positive and encouraging feedback. Please be assured that we remain committed to continually improving behaviour and learning. Year 10 lessons will be visited more frequently to support students as they prepare for their examinations.

For those who indicated that their child had experienced bullying, it is pleasing to see that all felt the school responded quickly and effectively. We encourage parents to continue contacting us with any concerns. Many issues we address relate to friendship difficulties rather than bullying in the traditional sense. You can support us by encouraging students to avoid arguments and to refrain from using social media to share comments or viewpoints about one another.
