As we approach the halfway point of the academic year and the end of Spring Term 1, this is a good opportunity to remind everyone of our expectations:

Uniform

Please ensure that students arrive in full school uniform every day, including appropriate footwear and any required items for PE. Please check your child's school shirt to ensure they are able to fasten their top button and that they are wearing their tie correctly.

All hair colours should be natural, and jewellery should be kept to a minimum. Facial piercings are not permitted.

Maintaining high standards of dress reflects our commitment to a positive learning environment. Where there is an infringement of the uniform code, the school reserves the right to contact home. Parents and carers may be asked to collect their child and return them once uniform issues have been resolved.

Attendance

Regular attendance is essential for academic success. We expect all students to attend school every day unless there is a valid reason for absence. If your child is unwell or unable to attend, please inform the school promptly following our usual procedures. All absence below 90% will be coded as unauthorised unless appropriate evidence is provided.

We will be launching our end-of-term rewards trip shortly after half term for students with 95% attendance and above. Further information will follow. Attendance figures for eligibility will either be based on Spring Term data (Tuesday 6th January – Friday 6th March) or cumulatively for the year (September–March). This means that students who were not eligible at the end of last term have every opportunity to meet the threshold this term.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us uphold these standards. Together, we can ensure that every student has the best possible start to the next half term.
