Dear Parents and Carers

I hope this letter finds you well. As the new Head of Physical Education at Ludlow CE School, I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself and to thank you for the continued support you have shown the PE department over the past half term.

It has been fantastic to see such a noticeable improvement in students arriving prepared and appropriately equipped for their PE lessons. The standard of PE kit across the school has improved significantly, and this has had a very positive impact on participation, presentation, and students' readiness to learn. Thank you for your support in helping us maintain these high standards.

As a reminder, students are expected to attend all PE lessons in the correct PE kit unless notice has been given to a member of the PE department explaining the reason why this may not be possible.

Our PE kit requirements are as follows:

Compulsory Ludlow CE School Branded PE Item

- Navy and white PE T-shirt (available in either fitted or loose-fit styles)

Additional PE Kit Requirements

- Boys: Plain navy shorts or plain navy tracksuit bottoms
- Girls: Plain black leggings or plain navy shorts
- All students: Plain white sports socks, or navy/white or navy/white/pink football socks and alternative pair of footwear appropriate for the sport being taught.
- Optional: ¾ zip jumper

In addition, we would like to clarify that short variations of leggings, such as Nike Pros or similar athletic compression shorts, are not part of the school PE kit policy and should not be worn for PE lessons. Students should instead wear plain black leggings or plain navy shorts in line with the agreed uniform expectations.

We believe that wearing the correct PE kit helps students feel part of the school community, promotes safety during lessons, and supports a positive attitude towards physical activity.
